

Math Homework Guidelines

What does EXCELLENT math homework look like?

Top of the Page...

- First and last name
- Period #
- Homework Lesson # and Problems

The Basics...

- All work must be done in pencil
- Fold your paper in half (lengthwise)
- Number each problem
- After each problem, draw a line then skip a space before you start the next problem.
- All graphs must be drawn on GRAPH PAPER or COORDINATE PLANES
- All lines are made using a RULER
- Papers stapled together (as needed)
- All work done neatly



The Details...

- You must show work for each problem (or provide an explanation) to JUSTIFY YOUR ANSWER.
- If you do not understand a problem, you must write down ALL KEY INFORMATION and WRITE A SPECIFIC QUESTION about the problem in order to receive credit.
- Write your answer clearly after all of your work is shown and put a box/circle around it.

Grading Homework...

- Homework will be corrected and graded in class using a pen
- For any problem that is incorrect, you must correct BOTH your work and your answer to receive full credit. (Use a separate sheet of paper as needed.)
- Your final homework grade will be based on following the format guidelines, your initial effort, and making all necessary corrections.
